### NEWCOMER BLIXT LEADS SEMINOLE MEN'S GOLF TEAM AT BANK OF TENNESSEE INTERCOLLEGIATE

JONESBOROUGH, Tenn. – Florida State University freshman Jonas Blixt shot a three-over par 75 in Sunday's final round of the Bank of Tennessee Intercollegiate at the Ridges Golf and Country Club and finished in a tie for 35<sup>th</sup> place in the individual standings to lead the Seminoles in their first event of the fall season. Playing in his first collegiate event Blixt finished six-over par to lead the quintet of Seminoles in the event with a three-over par score of 222.

Tennessee won the team title as the Vols carded the best single-round team score -- an eight-under par 280 -- of the tournament in the final round to beat TCU by four strokes. The Vols are ranked No. 30 in the preseason poll by *Golfweek* Magazine. Clemson, ranked second in the nation, finished in third in the team standings seven strokes behind Tennessee and four behind TCU. Phillip Pettitt of Tennessee won the individual title with an eight-under par score of 208 for the three-round event. Florida State finished 15<sup>th</sup> in the team standings.

Blixt (Nassjo, Sweden) played well in his first event as a Seminole with a three-over par 75 in the final round. He again played very consistently as he finished 13 of the 18 holes during the round at par or better. He birdied two holes and was in contention to shoot an even par score before carding bogies on three of the final four holes of the day. Still, he played the final two rounds at one over par after carding a two-under par 70 in the second round.

Sophomore Bradley Ruch (Louisville, Ky.) enjoyed the best round of the third day for the Seminoles as he carded a two-under par 70. Ruch came within one stroke of tying his career-best single round score -- a 69 in the second round of the spring 2004 Atlanta Intercollegiate. Ruch played the final 36 holes of the event in one-under par total of 143.

Junior Adam Wallace (Ponte Vedra Beach, Fla.) finished tied for 50<sup>th</sup> in the individual standings after tying his career-best effort over 36 holes (145) during the first two days of the tournament. Senior Matt Adcock (Apopka, Fla.) finished tied for 59<sup>th</sup> and senior Mark Sestilio (Punta Gorda, Fla.) finished in 79<sup>th</sup> place.

Florida State continues its four-event fall schedule at the Mason Rudolph Collegiate Championship at the Golf Club of Tennessee in Nashville Sept. 27-28.

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### **Tennessee sweeps team, individual honors at the Bank of Tennessee Intercollegiate at The Ridges**

**JOHNSON CITY, Tenn. (September 12, 2004)** – Tennessee's Philip Pettitt may be a freshman, but he certainly looked like a savvy veteran in the final round of his first collegiate event Sunday at the Bank of Tennessee Intercollegiate at The Ridges.

Pettitt posted a final round 67 and finished at 8-under-par (69-72-67=208), capturing the individual championship while also powering the Volunteers to the team title. Pettitt ended his round on No. 18 with an exciting 18-foot birdie putt that put an explanation point on the Tennessee triumph.

"I knew the tournament was close, and once I heard the cheer when it went in, I knew the putt was probably a little more important than I thought," Pettitt said. "I was in play all weekend with my driver and I was putting the ball well the whole tournament. That was the difference for me."

Pettitt held off Oklahoma's Anthony Kim by two strokes for the victory, while the Volunteers bested TCU by three strokes for the team title. Kim, who is a sophomore this season, won the Phil Mickelson award last season, which goes to the top freshman in the country. Pettitt said winning that award is his goal this year.

"It's still early and there's a lot of season left, but that is one of my goals," Pettitt said. "My summer was not the greatest, but this certainly was nice."

East Tennessee State, the host team, entered the tournament without two of its best players – sophomore Rhys Davies and freshman Cian McNamara, who were playing internationally back in Scotland – and finished the tournament tied for 13<sup>th</sup>. Despite that placing, ETSU head coach **Fred Warren** was encouraged by his team's play, especially in the final round.

"I think we finished on a high note," Warren said. "I saw some good things from our team, especially from some guys who got to play this weekend since Rhys and Cian were out. We have a better team this year and I think we're going to be much more competitive. Hosting this event always helps us in the long run."

For ETSU, senior **Cennydd Mills** (Cardiff, Wales) led the way by finishing tied for 10<sup>th</sup> at even-par, while freshman **Gareth Shaw** (Lisburn, Northern Ireland) finished tied for 25<sup>th</sup> at 3-over.
