SEMINOLE MEN'S GOLF TEAM CLAIMS TOP-10 FINISH AT INVERNESS INTERCOLLEGIATE MEN'S GOLF TOURNAMENT

TOLEDO, Ohio – Florida State University sophomore golfer Matthew Savage finished tied for 20th in the individual standings to lead the Seminole men's golf team to a ninth place finish at the Inverness Intercollegiate at the Inverness Golf Club as play in the event came to a close Tuesday afternoon. Savage and teammate Jonas Blixt both earned top 30 individual finishes in leading the Seminoles to a top-10 team in their first event of the fall season.

Southern California rallied from eight strokes down entering the third round to defeat TCU and win the team championship. The Trojans were led by two golfers – Jamie Lovemark and Tom Glissmeyer – in the top five of the individual standings in earning the team title. Jon McLean of TCU claimed individual medalist honors as he carded a two-over par score of 214 to defeat Manuel Villegas of Florida by four strokes.

Savage (Louisville, Ky.) played well in the second and third rounds of the event as he carded identical scores of 75 and finished with a three-round total of 229. He moved up six positions in the individual standings as he carded a 75 in the final round to the fifth top 20 finish of his career. Savage advanced to the quarterfinals of the 2006 U.S. Amateur Public Links Championship and played in the prestigious 2006 U.S. Amateur Tournament this past summer.

Seminole junior Jonas Blixt (Hammars, Sweden) was the biggest mover in the tournament in the third round as he carded a one-over par 72 to finish tied for 29th in the individual standings. He moved from a tie for 58th place after the second round into a tie for 29th place in the final standings – an amazing move of 29 positions. Blixt cut eight strokes off his first round score of 80 as he grew comfortable with the golf course in the first event of the year for the Seminoles.

Junior Tommy Rymer (Hastings, Minn.) earned the fifth top-40 finish of his career as he placed tied for 37th in the individual standings. He carded a junior-season best score of even par 71 in the first round of the event. Sophomore Nicholas Smith (Ocala, Fla.) and junior Song Jeon (Seoul, Korea) also participated in the event for the Seminoles.

Southern California (896) made up for letting its second-round lead at the 2005 Inverness Intercollegiate slip away by registering a three-stroke victory today over second-round leader TCU (899). The Trojans' margin of victory equaled last year's three-stroke difference between Florida and USC. Today's action was played in a driving rain throughout most of the round at the par-71, 7,255-yard Inverness Club.

The final results featured a tight leaderboard with Florida (900) finishing four shots back and Coastal Carolina (901) only five away from the lead. Georgia (904) and UNLV (906) were in fifth and sixth place, respectively.

Individually, TCU's Jon McLean (69-72-73--214) captured medalist honors by leading wire-to-wire and finished one stroke away from tying the tournament record. Florida's Manuel Villegas (74-76-68-218) finished in second place after firing the best round of the day with a three-under par 68. Rounding out the top five was USC's Jamie Lovemark (72-75-72-219), Coastal Carolina's Dustin Johnson (76-73-71-220) and USC's Tom Glissmeyer (74-74-73-221).

Toledo finished in a 12th-place tie (931) with Illinois and squandered away an impressive first-round performance that found the Rockets in third place. It was a repeat of last year's tournament when UT was in second place after the first round and ended up tied for seventh place.

Junior Justin Hull (71-78-77-226) led the Rockets by tying for 10th place, while fellow classmate Renaud Langevin (77-73-79--229) tied for 20th place. Rounding out the Rocket lineup were junior Ciaran McAleavey (77-80-81-238) in 57th place and senior Tyler Riley (77-80-82-239) tied for 58th place. Toledo Bowsher graduate and freshman Adam Crisp (84-86-81-251) finished in 75th place.

Toledo stands in an eighth-place tie (302-311--613) with MAC rival Kent State following the first two rounds of the sixth-annual Inverness Intercollegiate Invitational today at the par-71, 7,255-yard Inverness Club. The Rockets were in third place following the first round and trailed only TCU and Coastal Carolina.

Tournament officials also announced that tomorrow's final round will begin with an 8:30 a.m. shotgun start due to expected inclement weather. Teams were originally slated to tee off individually beginning at 8:00 a.m.

UT trails tournament leader TCU by 19 strokes with the Horned Frogs leading the 15-team field with a 26-over par 594 (295-299). Southern Cal (303-299) and Coastal Carolina (299-303) are tied for second place, eight strokes out of first place. Following the Trojans and Chanticleers in a tie for fourth place are SEC powers Georgia (305-301) and Florida (303-303) at 606. The Gators are the tournament's defending champions and came from 12 shots behind to win last year's event, the same margin that UF trails TCU following today's action. Texas A&M (608) and UNLV (611) are in sixth and seventh place, respectively.

Individually, TCU's Jon McLean (69-72--141) leads the 75-player field by six strokes and was the only player to be at par or under in the first two rounds. Rocket junior Justin Hull (71-78-149) is tied for fifth place with fellow classmate Renaud Langevin (77-73--150) tied for 10th place. Hull was tied for second place after the opening round but a triple bogey on the 16th hole and a double bogey on the 17th hole hurt his chances to be higher in the standings. Langevin rebounded from a six-over par 77 in the opening round with a one-under par 35 on the back nine of his second round.

"We really played well in the first round but we need to learn how to sustain that type of effort throughout the whole day," UT Head Coach Jamie Mauntler said. "Justin and Renaud were our two most consistent players and that's good to see after they both worked very hard on their games over the summer.

Rounding out the Rocket lineup are junior Ciaran McAleavey (77-80--157) and senior Tyler Riley (77-80-157) tied for 45th place and Toledo Bowsher graduate and freshman Adam Crisp (84-86-170) in 75th place.
