

FSU Swimming Team Defeated

The Florida State University swimming team surprised a heavily favored Miami tank squad Saturday by extending the Hurricanes to the limit before losing 42-33.

The Seminoles, who were outclassed twice last year by the Canes 62-7 and 63-13, took first place in four events in the dual meet witnessed by 2,000 fans in the Pate General hospital pool.

The Miami 300-meter relay team established the only new pool mark set during the evening in winning the event.

FSU's first places were won by Roger Slater in the diving event, Frank Cochran in the 50-yard free style and 200 meter breast-stroke and the 400-meter free-style relay team composed of Cochran, Warren, Frost, Jack White and Mark Brown.

The Seminoles scored heavily in the place and show positions to build up their total.

U-M Swimmers Defeat Florida State, 42-33

University of Miami's last swimming meet under coach Tom Lamar resulted in the Hurricane's 13th consecutive victory Saturday afternoon as they defeated Florida State University, 42-33, in the Biltmore pool.

The Miamians captured six of the nine events and set four records in the process, Capt. Bob Caffray establishing two of them.

Caffray bettered the old pool and U M standard by more than two seconds in the 220-yard free style with his clocking of 2:20.9. His 5:11.4 time in the 440-yard

free style topped the Biltmore pool mark in that test.

Bill Burrell shattered the 100-yard free style record, stroking the distance in :55.4 seconds. The last mark was clipped by the 300-yard medley relay trio of Don Fetterman, Cohen and Burrell.
