Georgia Cops Dual Meet 40-35

ATHENS, Ga., Jan. 28—The Georgia Bulldogs handed the Florida State University swimming team a 40-35 setback in a dual tank meet here this afternoon.

The defeat gave the Seminoles an even break on a two-meet tour of Georgia which opened their rugged 1950 schedule.

One pool record was established in the meet. The Bulldog 300-yard medley relay team hung up a new mark of 3:10.4 in winning the event. The Seminole team also shattered the old record as they pushed the Bulldogs to the limit.
