DALLAS. Texas — Southern Methodist University's swimming team turned its shorter pool into good advantage here last night and upset traveling Florida State 53-33.

The Mustang swimmers took both relay events to spring the upset on the Seminoles.

Florida State's Ryan Ray broke a six-year record, held by two former All-Americans from SMU, when he won the 50 yard freestyle race in the excellent time of :21.3.

The Seminoles defeated Rice and Texas A&M before losing their final meet in Texas to SMU.
