

Fla. State Natators Too Good for Wave

Locals Make Splendid Showing

Tulane's young swimming team put up one of its finest showings in its three year history Saturday afternoon while losing to powerful Florida State 49-41.

Coach Lowell Damonte's aquatic team broke the school record in the 400-yard freestyle relay when John Frelinger, Russ Hook, Richard Williamson and Jim Fulton raced to victory in the time of 3:4.2-5.

Fulton won the 50-yard freestyle, Hook the 100-yard freestyle, and John Jackson the 500-yard freestyle for the other three Green Wave first places.

Coach Bim Stults of FSU actually let the final score be closer than normal when he subbed freely in the final few races.
