

Florida State's swimming team captured a 67-46 victory over strong Alabama Saturday at the Union Pool.

The Seminoles won only six of the meets 13 first places but were able to capture second and third in each of the six individual events they did not win to gather the points for victory.

The Tribe jumped in front with a win in the Medley Relay, and continued to build their lead with wins in the one-meter diving (Randy Stewart), the 200-yd. freestyle (Seeley Feldmeyer), 50-yd. free (Dave Gibson) and three-meter diving (Ken VonRoenn).

Alabama made a gallant comeback try following the diving break as they captured five of the last six events, but it was not enough to overcome the Seminole lead. Florida State's lone win was by Dennis Shiels in the backstroke.

Two Crimson Tide swimmers set meet and pool records. Leo French covered the 1000-yd. freestyle in 10:26.2 for one new mark, and Ralph Wright's 2:00.8 in the Individual Medley was good for the other.

Feldmeyer and Gibson, both seniors, made their last dual meet performances winning ones as the Seminoles closed the year out with a 4-4 record. It was the poorest mark for one of Coach Bim Stults team, since his first club went 3-5 in 1949.
