## Seminole **Swimmers** Fall 57-56

Florida State's young swimming team is learning the hard way, that the little things often mean just as much, if not more than the big ones.

The Seminoles lost their second dual meet of the season, here, yesterday when Tulane, edged the Tribe, 57-56.

But that is just part of the story. This marks the third meet this year in which the Seminoles have failed to place higher by two points or less. In a meet in December, the Tribe was just two points behind South Carolina. Last weekend, FSU placed third in the six team Tennessee Relays, just two points behind second place Auburn.

In each case there were sev-eral "little things" that the Tribe had go wrong, that spelled the difference.

"It is really frustrating," said a disappointed Coach Terry Carlisle, following the Tulane meet. "This is the third time we should have had the points we needed.

"We just have people not doing the things they should. I don't know what we can do to correct it, but we will have to think of something."

"The "little things" in Monday's meet were a disqualification, one missed dive and a judges decision which resulted in a first place tie. Of course a strong effort by Tulane's fast improving swim squad was the biggest factor.
