

Swim meet off

For the second straight weekend, the Seminoles' swim team will have the Union Pool all to themselves, as another opponent has cancelled a scheduled meet.

Florida Technological University of Orlando informed the athletic department earlier this week they would be unable to field a team for this weekend's meet.

Last week the University of Florida refused to swim the Seminoles, offering the same excuse. "I just can't believe this can happen on a collegiate level," exclaimed Head Coach Terry Carlisle. "We're putting it down as another forfeit."

Florida State will continue practicing for the Georgia meet next Friday in Athens and the South Carolina meet in Columbia the following day.

"I'm hoping we can stay sharp till next weekend," said Carlisle. "South Carolina is becoming a big rival for us because we're both strong southern independents. If we can win both meets next week, it will raise our overall record to 8-3, which I think is fantastic."
