

## FSU Netters Seek Sixth Win

The Florida State University tennis team will go after its sixth consecutive victory of the season at the West Campus courts Friday afternoon when they meet Southern college's strong net squad.

Coach Don Loucks' Indian squad chalked up its fifth win in a row yesterday when they swept past the College of Charleston squad 5-3.

After winning their first four matches with the loss of only one set, FSU caught a tartar yesterday in the South Carolinians and were extended all the way before winning.
