

The Florida State University tennis team swept all six singles matches here yesterday afternoon to defeat Florida Southern College 7-2 at the East Campus varsity courts.

The victory was Florida State's seventh of the season against four defeats. The Seminoles left this morning on a road trip that will see them meet Florida Southern at Lakeland tomorrow afternoon, the Orlando AFB team at Orlando Friday, and Rollins College at Winter Park Saturday.

Jim Berry, Tom Cundy, Dave Kennedy, Joe Harris, Jack Egan, and Dan Boda all registered singles victories for the Seminoles in yesterday's match with Florida Southern here. Boda and Egan also combined talents to defeat the visitors in the No. 1 doubles match, but the visitors were saved from a shutout by taking the other two doubles.
