Netters, Rollins Vie In Season's Finale

Florida State's tennis team goes after the 9th win of the 1956 season this Saturday when they tangle with Rollins here, in the last meet of the season.

Winning only two matches, the Seminole netless were blasted by Florida's Gators, 7-2 Monday, in a match which was closer than the score indicated.

Tribe coach Keith Pitchford said that the Tribe "played very well, and relaxed and that the matches were much closer than the final score showed."

"I thought they were relaxed completely for the first time, and in particular Hal Schaus (number 1 man) finally opened up for the first time this year."

In addition to Schaus's victory the only other Seminole win came in the doubles where Schaus and Shelby Creagh won their doubles match.

"Rollins has a very tough team," he added, "but I think we can beat them if we play our best."
