

Georgia Tech's tennis team, a definite title contender in the Southeastern Conference this spring, defeated Florida State, 7-2, in a match here yesterday.

Tech swept all three of the doubles events and won four of the singles matches to notch its third win against a single setback this year.

Jim Maddock and Jackie Crew were the only FSU winners.

The loss evened the Seminoles' record at one win and one defeat. They opened last Wednesday with a 5-4 victory over the University of Georgia.
