The Seminoles' Paul Bennett also fell to Tech's other star, Paul Speicher, in three sets.

Steve Guse, Florida State's number five player, won singles matches against Tech and Navy, and also was with Terry Poore the only Seminoles to win in Friday's Mississippi State match.

The Seminoles have three

matches cheduled here this week. They take on Rutgers Monday and Tuesday and Valdosta State Wednesday, all beginning at 2 p.m. at the varsity courts.
