Tallahassee, Fla. --- Geoff Roper and Alex Rucker each won three-set matches to give the Florida State tennis team a 4-2 lead after singles play at the Seminoles went on to defeat Auburn 6-3 Friday at the Don Loucks Courts.

It was the third time this year that FSU, ranked 21st in the latest Intercollegiate Tennis poll, defeated the Tigers.

Senior Joey Rive and junior Jeff Horine picked up the other singles wins for Florida State at no. 1 and 4 respectively.

In doubles, Florida State's top two teams easily handled their Auburn opponents as Rive and Roper won 6-1,6-3 at no. 1 doubles and Horine teamed with Scott Blessing to take a 6-3, 6-0 win at no. 2.

The Seminoles go for their 20th win of the season tomorrow at 2 p.m. against McNeese State.
