Tallahassee, Fla. --- FSU's number two doubles team of Scott Blessing and Jeff Horine won a 6-2, 6-7, 6-2 decision over Rob Ureta and Uri

Persson of McNeese State to clinch a 5-4 Florida State tennis win. Saturday in Tallahassee.

Tied 3-3 going into the doubles matches, Florida State's other doubles win came at no. 1 where Joey Rive and Geoff Roper extended their winning streak to seven matches.

Rive, the Seminoles number one singles player, took a 7-5, 6-4 victory over Jan Kjelisten to raise his record to 19-3 on the year. Jeff Horine and Alex Rucker got the other singles wins for the Tribe.

With the win, FSU goes to 20-4 for 1985, and has its second 20-win season in as many years under head coach Richard McKee. Florida State plays Florida Tuesday in Gainesville in an attempt to avenge a 5-4 defeat at the hands of the Gators earlier this season.
