Tallahassee, Fla.-- Florida States' men's tennis team swept all six singles matches and two out of three doubles matches to defeat Florida Junior College 8-1 Tuesday afternoon at the Donald Loucks Varsity Courts.

The win improved FSU's record to 11-13 going into Thursday's Metro Conference Championships in Columbia, South Carolina. FJC fell to 21-14.

Florida Junior College forced five matches to go three sets. The Seminoles, however, won all five.

"It's encouraging when you win all five three-setters," FSU head coach Richard McKee said. "We needed this win to get some momentum going into the Metro Tournament."
