TAMPA, FL-- The Florida State softball team was eliminated in the quarterfinals by Oklahoma State 1-0 at the South Florida Invitational in Tampa, FL.

Oklahoma State threatened several times in the game but the Seminoles came up with big defensive plays to stave off the Cowgirls. With the bases loaded in the first and two aboard in the fourth, FSU pitcher Marla Looper ended the inning with a strikeout. In the fifth, FSU turned a double play to stifle an OSU rally.

In the sixth, OSU pinch runner Koni Coutts stole third and then scored when Looper's throw sailed over the third baseman's head.

Florida State was held hitless in the game and only managed to put three runners on base. Kim Ward struckout nine FSU batters.

Florida State falls to 21-4 overall. The Seminoles enter their busiest week of the season starting Tuesday as they have games everyday and host the Lady Seminole Invitational this weekend.

Florida State stands at 8-3 on the season. The Seminoles get back into ACC action on Thursday as they take on N.C. State in a 3:00pm match.
