TALLAHASSEE, FL -- In the final regular season match, the 26th-ranked Florida State women's tennis team defeated 27th-ranked South Alabama 7-2.

The match marked the last home outing for three Florida State seniors. Audra Brannon capped off a great FSU career with a 3-6, 6-1, 7-6 victory over Estelle Gevers at number one. Laura Randmaa beat Tamsin Staples 6-3, 6-0 while the third Seminole senior, Jennifer Hyde, teamed with Lori Sowell to earn a 7-6, 6-0 win at number two doubles over Adele Pearson and Staples.

Other singles winners for Florida State included Lori Sowell who downed Cami Harris 6-0, 6-4 and Ashley Delaney who fought back from a set deficit to defeat Joanne Crothers 4-6, 7-6, 6-1 at six.

The Seminoles finish the season with a 13-8 record. FSU travels to Charlotte, NC next weekend for the ACC Championships.
