Raleigh, N.C. - NC State's men's tennis lost to Florida State, 4-3.

FSU took two out of three doubles matches, taking a 1-0 lead into singles play. NC State's Roberto Bracone, ranked No. 85 in the nation, defeated Seminole Ty Braswell at No. 1 singles by default after winning the first set 7-6, he was ahead 1-0 before the default. This victory pushes Bracone's singles record to 17-5 on the year. The Wolfpack's #3 seed Jeff Smith defeated FSU's Alex Golub by default and NC State's #5 seed Hayes Calvert beat Seminole Steve Weinstein by default after leading, 7-5, 3-2.

The Wolfpack ends the regular season 7-16 overall and 1-7 in the Atlantic Coast Conference. The ACC Tournament begins Thursday, April 17 in Atlanta.
