

Florida State's track lineup yesterday for Georgia and Georgia Tech was rougher than the Seminoles had anticipated—but they accelerated to defeat Mercer University from Macon in the Peach state, 73½-53½.

Four Indians came through as expected—they were double-winners who continued to set track and school records in a variety of events.

Captain John Poston of Jacksonville paced the squad with his customary sprint victories and a terrific mile relay leg. Poston ran 9.9 in the century and 21.5 in the 220, shattering his previous school record there by one-tenth of a second. Then he turned in a 40.4 anchor lap on the concluding mile relay.

#### FRESH DOUBLE WINNERS

Slender weight man Carlos Fraundorfer, hurdler Jule Hurst, and middle-distance runner Bill Wagoner—all freshmen—also recorded a pair of wins apiece that included several records.

Fraundorfer put the shot 44'4" for a school record and set another one in the discus with 135' 4". It was the third straight meet in which he's broken the shot record.

Sophomore Woody Parker raged :51.0 flat in the quarter-mile to break his own track record. And the mile relay quartet of Poston, Dick Mize, Pete Ninkoff, and Jack Koonee shattered all existing local marks with 3:27. Mize, back after a prolonged layoff, and Poston sparked that win with sizzling quarters.
