Georgia's well-balanced track squad had more depth than Georgia Tech and Florida State and came up with a triangular victory at FSU's West Campus oval yesterday.

The winning Bulldogs racked up 80½ points to 58 for Georgia Tech and 53½ for Coach Ken Miller's Seminoles. It was the first home meet of the season for FSU.

The Seminoles had five first-place—three by Jimmy Casteel—as did Georgia. Georgia Tech had six first-place finishers.

Casteel, a promising freshman from Avondale, Ga., picked up firsts in the 220 and 440-yard dashes and the broad jump. His 220 time of 21.7 seconds tied a meet record and his 43.3 second effort in the 440 was good for a track record.

Casteel had 16½ points in all, giving him individual honors. Carl Vereen, Georgia Tech's great shot put and discus prospect, easily won both his specialties. Only a freshman, Vereen's 151-foot discus throw and 50-foot, one-inch shot heave established new track and meet records.

Georgia's best performer was junior Kermit Perry, a hurdles ace who captured both the 220-yard lows and 110 highs.

It was the first defeat Georgia and Georgia Tech handed the Seminoles in three years. FSU won both the '52 and '53 three-way clashes.

Georgia Tech, which led most of the way, came near winning its first track meet in three years. But Georgia landed the first three places in the javelin throw—next to last event on the program—to sew it up.
