

GAINESVILLE, April 14 (AP)—Florida's track team took 13 of 15 first places for a 90-41 victory over Florida State University today. The dual meet opened official track rivalry between the two state-supported schools.

The Seminoles averted a rout by taking a host of second and third places in addition to their first places in the javelin throw and broad jump.

Lincoln Knoles, Jim Smith, and Don Crozier were Florida's individual stars, each winning two events.

Smith took point-making honors with victories in the 100 and 220-yard dashes, and second place in the 220-yard low hurdles. Knoles, who won the 120-yard high and 220-yard low hurdles, also ran a leg on Florida's winning mile relay as did Crozier, winner of the 440 and 800 events.

Crozier took the lead from the FSU runner in the final lap of the mile relay.

Ron Weaver heaved the javelin 194 feet 1 inch for one of the Seminoles' first places and Joe Davis picked up the other with a 22-foot 6 1/4-inch leap in the broad jump.

Florida's Jack West narrowly

denied FSU a win in the mile run when he nosed Mike Conley in the last few feet to take first place in 4 minutes 29.9 seconds.

Florida's freshmen, led by sprinter Ellis Goodloe, defeated FSU 12-2 in the fresh division. Goodloe ran the 100 in 9.7 seconds, bettering the varsity effort of 9.9 by Smith.
