With seniors Tom Keeney and Ross Harrison scoring double victories, Florida State kept its dual track record clean with an 85-23-50 1-0 triumph over Furman here yesterday.

Ten of the 16 events were won by the Seminoles, who clash with Southeastern Conference Louisiana State in an important dual meet here Thursday.

Keeney won first places in the mile and two-mile runs and Harrison breezed home first in the low hurdles and 220-yard dash. Harrison was clocked in 21 seconds flat in the 220.

Other individual winners for the Tribe were Quentin Till in the 440, Ted Keen in the 100, Billy Welch in the high hurdles; Ed Hays in the pole vault, and Steve Long in the high jump.

Winner over Miami in their first dual start, the Seminoles have won 25 of 29 dual meets under Coach Mike Long.
