

GREENVILLE, S. C.—Senior team captain Don Ostergaard set a school shot-put record here yesterday as Florida State racked up its third straight Piedmont Relays crown in impressive fashion.

Coach Mike Long's Seminoles freshmen with a first-place finish rolled up 112¾ points to 74¾ for runner-up Furman. Further back were The Citadel (45½, Clemson (25), and Davidson (23).

Ostergaard tossed the shot 54 feet, one-half inch to top his own school mark of 53-7¾ set last season.

Senior Steve Long established a meet record with a winning effort of 6 feet, 3½ inches in the high jump. Other first-place individual winners for FSU were Dave Ellis in high hurdles, Herb Kraft in the broad jump, and Jeff Clark in the discus.

The Tribe scored heavily in the field events and had first-place finishes in the 440 and 880-yard relay events. FSU placed second in four other relays, losing by inches to host Furman in both the sprint medley and mile relays.
