Johnson sped the 100 in 10-flat, registered a 21.8 clocking in the 280. Husky Clark heaved the shot 40-1034, won the discus with a 151-9 distance.

The only double winner for the Gamecock's was Ed Cribb, who ran the mile in 4:20.3 and the 3-mile in 10:12.7.
