Weightman Al Williams' trip west on behalf of Florida State last week resulted in a fourth place finish in the NCAA Championships in Albuquerque, New Mexico, but Williams failed in his goal to turn in the Southland's first sixty foot shot put.

Williams' toss of 57-7 in the NCAA meet Saturday earned him

a fourth-place berth behind champion Gary Gubner of NYU, who won with 62-5, Dave Steen of Oregon, and John McGrath of Occidental.

Williams bettered his showing of June 8th at the U. S. Track and Field Federation meet in Houston, Texas, when he threw the shot 57-4, and also heaved the discus 157 feet. Williams did not compete in the discus at the NCAA meet.

A 235-pounder from Atlanta's O'Keefe High, Williams is now the nation's 2nd ranked junior in the shot put; Gubner, also a third-year man, is ranked first.

Williams' toss in the shot of 58-10 in the Georgia AAU meet last month was the fourth best collegiate throw this year.

He hopes to take up the hammer throw soon and enter competition in that event next year. Al said he tried the hammer

throw while in Albuquerque after observing competition in that event. He said Mike Long, FSU Track mentor, plans now to purchase a hammer and ship it to Williams' home in Atlanta, where Al will be working with a construction company during the summer.
