

TAMPA — Florida State stormed from behind in the final two events to overtake the University of Florida and win the first annual Jesuit Invitational Track Meet by ten points here yesterday.

The Seminoles trailed the Gators going into the mile relay, but the FSU team of Wayne Currie, Ross Winter, Curt Long and John Brogle came home in 3:16.8 to win. Miami and Florida A&M took second and third, relegating Florida to fourth.

Meanwhile, Don Casteel and Sid Gainey were racking up a one-two finish in the triple jump, to make FSU's final total of 64 points. Florida finished with 54, followed by Florida A&M with 32 and Miami with 31.

Florida State's Ken White won both the 100 and 220 yard dashes and was chosen the meet's outstanding per-

Sid Gainey, although troubled with a painful leg injury, won his fifth straight broad jump title without a defeat with a jump of 23-10 $\frac{1}{2}$ .

Other first place winners for the Seminoles were Steve Landis in the intermediate hurdles and Jack Flandreau in the pole vault.

Florida A&M won the junior college and freshman division with 58 $\frac{1}{2}$  points. Florida was second with 45 $\frac{1}{2}$ , FSU third with 29.

Florida A&M's appearance marked the first time the Rattlers have competed with FSU, Florida and Miami in a track meet.
