Florida State's Ken White wong both the 100 and 220 yard dashes and was chosen the meet's outstanding per-

former in the college division.

Florida A&M's Don Smith was the meet's only other double winner with victories in the shot put and discus.

Sid Gainey, although troubled with a painful leg injury, won his fifth straight broad jump title without a defeat with a jumy of 23-1014.

Other first place winners for the Seminoles were Steve Landis in the intermediate hurdles and Jack Flandreau in the pole vault

Florida A&M won the junior college and freshman division with 58½ points. Florida was second with 45½, FSU third with 29.

Florida A&M's appearance marked the first time the Rattlers have competed with FSU, Florida and Miami in a track meet.
