GAINESVILLE (AP) — Ten records fell Saturday in the 16-event Florida Relays dominated collectively by Tennessee and individually by Florida sophomore John Morton.

Over 2,000 athletes and 6,000 sun-soaked fans were on hand for the 24th annual event featuring some of the finest trackmen in squads.

Morton received the Kearney-Rayburn Memorial Trophy as the outstanding performer of meet. There was no official scoring.

The 6-foot-5, 250-pound Morton heaved the discus to a relay and track record with a toss of 187 feet 8½ inches. Morton, from Miami, also won the shot put with a throw of 55 feet, 10½ inches.

The University of Tennessee dominated the meet as the Volunteers set four relay records.

Florida A&M's Kenneth Brown set a new record in the high jump with a leap of 6'8". The

old mark was 6'7 ¾".

Eugene Milton took a second in the 100-yard dash for A&M, while Thomas was first in the triple jump for the Rattlers. The FAMU 440-yard relay team played second.

Mike Kelly of FSU placed

third in the 440-yard intermediate hurdles while Charles Vickers was fifth in that event and fifth in the high hurdles.

The Seminoles' Sprint medley and distant sprint medley relay teams both finished fifth.
