TUSCALOOSA, Ala. — A clutch performance by Florida State's mile relay team powered the Seminoles to a 73-72 track victory over Alabama here Saturday.

Trailing 71-60 with two events to go, the Seminoles captured both the three mile and mile relay competition over the stubborn Tide.

FSU's Ken Misner and teammate Del Ramers placed one-two in the mile to make the score 72-68 in favor of Alabama.

The team of Steve Oulman, Bernie Waxman, Mike Link and Randy Stow then set a new school and meet record of 3:13.3 to whip the Tide in the mile relay and take the decisive win. The old mark was 3:13.5 set last year.

Misner also finished first in the one mile with a 4:11.9 clocking, and again was followed by Ramers.

Jim Sauers set a new FSU record in the high jump with a leap of six feet, eight inches, and Charlie Galloway gave the Seminole another first in the long jump with his leap of 23 feet, two inches.

Galloway picked up another first in the triple jump with a distance of 47 feet, one and three-quarters inches.

Oulman placed first in the 880 yard run with a time of

1:52.8. Doug Brown was second in the 120 hurdles and the 100 yard dash.

Dave Barton led a clean sweep for the Seminoles in the discus with a toss of 156 feet, six and one-half inches. John Snyder was second and George Frank third. Roy Dunn got FSU a second in the javelin.

The victory pushed the Tribe's record to 4-1 before its meeting with Florida A&M next Friday.
