Though the Seminoles recorded no first in the meet that had many of the top people in the nation competing, the Tribe did pick up two thirds for their highest finishes. Those places came in the pole wault and the two-mile relay.

Allan McMillen finished third in the vaulting event, but was not as impressive in doing it as he has been in the past month. His height was only 15-6 as compared to his 16-1½ leap that he recorded two weekends ago.

"We would like to think that Allan could have done better," said Long of the third place effort. "He just got a new lighter pole and he may not have totally adjusted to it yet."

Long did get one very pleasant surprise from the event as the team's No. 3 vaulter Keith Ingram, finished an impressive sixth with a personal high vault of 15-0. Ingram, who usually doesn't go to many meets because he is only No. 3, went to the Dogwood event because the regular No. 2 Seminole performer was out with an injury.

The two mile relay produced a fine performance from all concerned as the team of Bob Fleming, Wes Koenig, Robin McEachern and Bob Brooks ran the distance in 7:45. Koenig recorded the fastest of the splits for the event with a 1:54 clocking in his half mile.

Chuck Crowder continued to establish himself as the Seminoles most consistent performer as he took a fourth in a field of shotput men that was respectable nationally. He lost to only one other collegian

as he heaved the 16-pounder 54-2.

FSU placed officially in only one other field event as Jim Buck took sixth in the javelin. This place was misleading because only one collegian was ahead of Buck in the strong field of amateurs. Roy Dunn, also of Florida State, finished seventh in the final standings.

Another of the pleasant surprises Long found at the Knoxville meet was Jim Cunningham who came through with a sixth place finish in the high hurdles. "This is one event we badly needed a place in," said Long of Cunningham's accomplishment. "I am really sort of pleased that we now have a man who can be competitive in the hurdles."

Since the meet was basically for relay teams, Florida State entered mostly relays, however. In many cases, it did well.

Other than the two-mile event, the Tribe also finished in the top six of the 880-relay, the distance medley and the mile.

In the latter of these events, the Tribe took a fifth in the mile relay despite one weak leg of the four run. The most pleasing aspect of this race for Long was that star quarter miler Joel Garren ran his fastest time of the year in the 440 as he recorded a 46.7 split to anchor this race.

The Seminoles also got fifths in both of the other relays. In the distance medley, the team of Jack Wise, George Sparling, Del Ramers and Brooks came through, while in the half mile, Jimmy Cofer, Cunningham, Mark Middleton and Harold Smith competed.

One of the team members

Long was most impressed with was Cofer who took part in the sprint medley, 440 and 880-relays as the leadoff man and ran good times in all of them.

The Seminoles now get off the relay meet circuit they have been caught up in for the past month and go to the LSU Invitational this Saturday in Baton Rouge, La.

Long feels this is one of the most important meets that the Tribe will compete in this season because, 'It will not only establish our strength as a dual meet team, but also will give our men who are good enough a chance to qualify for the national finals."

Long said that the Baton Rouge track is ideal for good times and, with the six or so other teams that will be at the meet, the competition should be good.
