at rain soaked competition Tracksters dominate own meet

Florida State won all field events but one and came through with ten victories as the Seminoles dominated their own Southeastern Independents Track and Field Championships on University Track Saturday night.

With rain falling all afternoon and the threat of more hanging over the meet, the track wasn't ideal, Good time were still recorded, however.

Only three teams competed in the meet: FSU, Baptist College and Georgia Tech. Tech's entry was nowehere near a full squad. FSU was most impressive in the field events as the Tribe swept at least the top three in many.

The javelin, which has always been a strong event for the Tribe, stayed that way as the Seminoles took a 1-2-3 sweep. Jim Buck came through with a 226-foot heave to win it and Roy Dunn and Bob Jarry finished second and third respectively.

FSU also took a big sweep in the high jump as the Seminoles finished in the top five positions. Bill Stinson ended up in first with a leap of 6-6 and Jim Cunningham was second at 6-4. Steve Smith also jumped 6-4 and finished third.

The pole vault also produced another Tribe sweep as Allan McMillan, Ron Fletcher and Keith Ingram finished in the top three places. McMillan vaulted 15-6 for the home folks while Fletcher cleared 15 feet and Ingram managed 14-6.

Other Tribe field victories were recorded in the shot put and the long jump. Bernie Waxman took the jumping event with a 23-9% effort and senior captain Chuck Crowder heaved the shot 51-11% to win. This was the final meet of both trackmen's career at Florida State.

In the running events, the Seminoles recorded wins in the 440-yard relay, the 100-yard dash, the 220, mile relay and three-mile run.

Possibly the most impressive of the men was Joel Garren, who, for the second straight week, ran a time in the 220 that qualified him for national competition. FSU also took third and fourth in this event with Jimmy Cofer and Harold Smith netting these positions respectively.

The Seminoles also made an impressive showing by winning both relays. In the quarter miler, the team of Cofer, Smith, Eddie McMillan and Garren broke the tape in the fast time of 41.2. FSU took the mile with the crew of George Sparling, Waxman, Wes Koenig and Garren running a 440 each.
