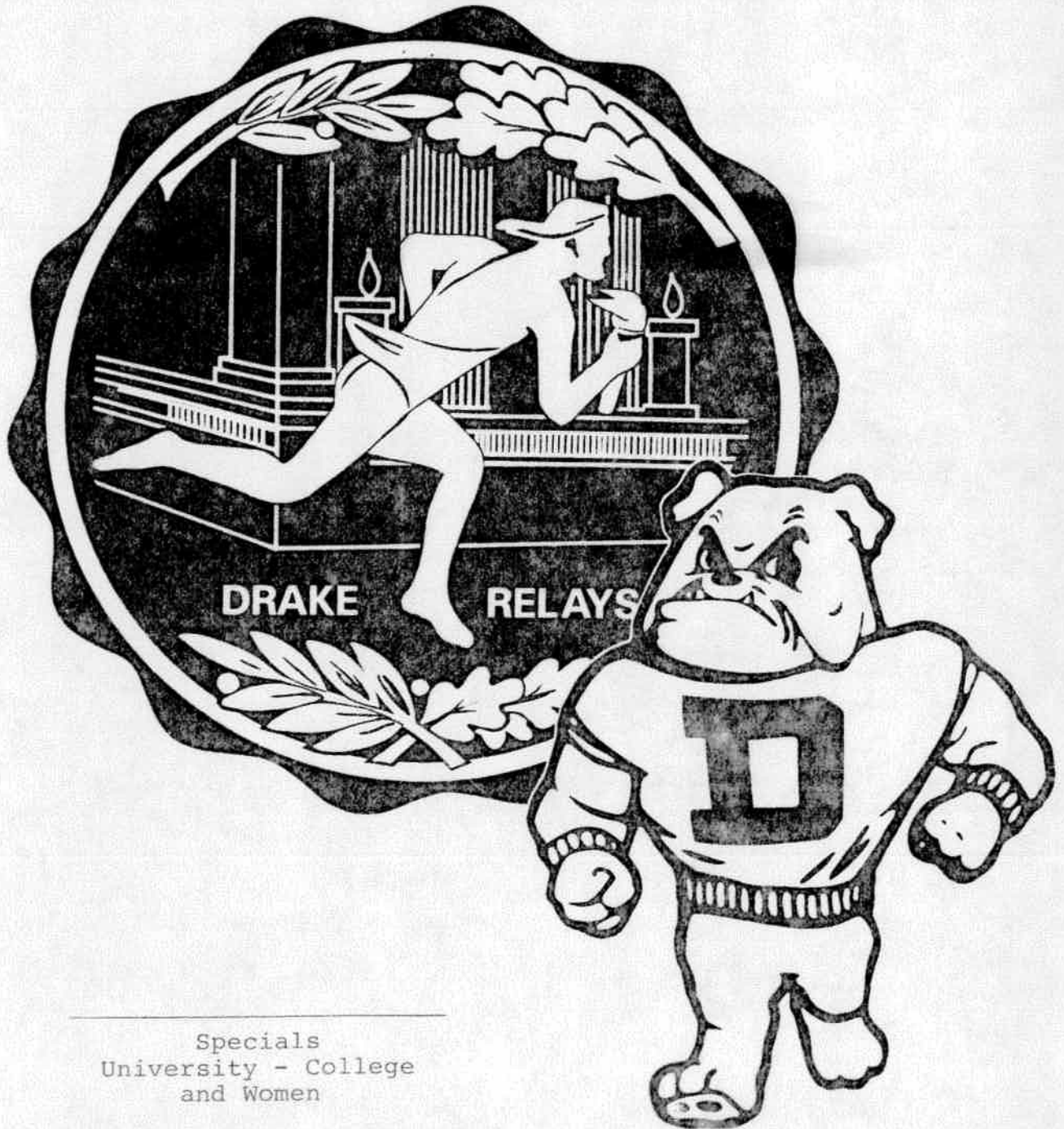

Once I got around the Cal-Poly guy, I was pretty sure I had it. I tired a little in the stretch though.

Desmond Ross, Oklahoma State, winner 100-Meter Dash in 10.36

About 40 yards from the finish, I felt pretty good and started pumping my arms and knees. I got a good start and that's really the key to my whole race.

Michelle Maxey, Kansas State, winner Women's 400 in 52.39

It feels really good, I didn't expect this at all. I just wanted to get out and run my best. I never really felt like I had the race totally in control. It's never over until you pass that finish line.

Ron Backes, Minnesota, winner University-College Shot Put 61-8 1/4

I've been having some trouble in the middle of the season with my technique. I feel I've been competing well in meets though. I've been working constantly on weights and not really trying to peak for any meets. I've been pretty consistent in distance but I'm trying to work it back up to the mid 60s for NCAAAs.

Paul Emordi, Texas Southern, winner University-College Triple Jump in DRAKE RELAYS RECORD

I had a good series today. It's a pleasure to break the record set by Charlton Ehizuelen. We're from the same state in Nigeria. We went to the Penn Relays last year but we're trying to go to different meets this year so I can compete against all the top jumpers. I want to be the best in the world.

I had to slow down by first six steps because the runway is a little shorter than I'm used to. When I came out this morning it was rather cool and I was a little scared. I'm used to the warm weather in Texas. But ~~when~~ the sun came out at 1:00 when we started jumping. I'm very happy with this win even though it's off my PR of 56-3 3/4.

Willie Caldwell, Baylor, second-place Men's Special 400 in 45.56

It was my first time running against Harris. I never had anyone that close to me this year and I got scared so I tied up a little bit and that cost me the race. I got out a little quick. I made up the stagger before I got out of the corner so I should have slowed down a little.
