TALLAHASSEE, FL--The Florida State men's and women's swimming and diving teams defeated the University of Miami Friday afternoon in dual meet competition at the Stults Aquatic Center.

The men's meet came down to a thrilling 400 Freestyle relay, won by the Seminoles in runaway fashion, giving FSU a 61-52 victory, as the men earned all seven points in the event. Jeff Feldman got the Seminoles out to an early lead as Richard Greenwood, Matt Muller and Charlie Rose expanded it, finishing in 3:07.79, nearly ten seconds ahead of the Canes.

The women raced to an early lead with a win in the opening 400 Medley relay. Valerie Moore, Danielle VanDyke, Kathy Isackson, and Kirsten Harrington finished in just under four minutes.

Van Dyke, a 1989 honorable mention All-American, took individual honors in the 50 Free and 200 Breast for the Lady Seminoles, 2-0. Isackson won the 200 Fly and freshman Valerie Moore and Missy Connolly won in the 200 Back and 1000 Free respectively.

The Florida State men's team, also undefeated in two starts, came back from an early deficit with sweeps in the 50 Free and 200 IM. Muller and Dieter Holtz took those events respectively. Charlie Rose outdistanced the field in the 200 Back as the Seminoles mainly took second and third places to offset the Hurricane winners.

Keith Frostad took the 500 and 1000 Free to lead Miami. The Canes also took the diving events behind Scott Whiddon and Christine Ramos, both claiming the 1 and 3 Meter boards.

Florida State will return to dual meet action November 11 at North Carolina State.
