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TALLAHASSEE, FLORIDA----The Florida State men's and women's swimming teams defeated Georgia State last night at the Myers Park Swimming Complex. The women's team defeated Florida Atlantic University in a seperate dual meet. The final scores were the Lady Seminoles winning by margins of 77-54 against Florida Atlantic, and 91-37 over Georgia State. The men's squad easily defeated Georgia State 90-47.

The real excitement began after the meet when Kathy Isackson of FSU swam a time trial and qualified for NCAA Championships in the 100 yard butterfly. Her time was 56:50, just about a tenth under the time standard. The men were led by senior Matt Muller, and junior Craig Zettle who each took first-place finishes in two events.

The teams travel to Gainesville this Saturday to tangle with the nationally ranked Gators. The women's squad is now 10-4, while the men up their record to 7-3. The meet Saturday will be the last dual meet of the year for both squads.
