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Florida State Women's Swimming Finishes First Day Of Georgia Invitational In Second Place

Men's swimming completes day one in third place.

ATHENS, Ga - The Florida State men's and women's swimming and diving teams completed first day action in the Georgia Invitational on the campus of the University of Georgia in Athens. FSU completed day one with four first place finishes, six top 5 finishes and eight top 10 finishes. Both squads also ended the day in the top 3 of the team standings.

The woman compiled 221 points on the first day of competition and finished ahead Clemson (220), NC State (176) and Florida Atlantic (7). The top-ranked Lady Bulldogs ended day one in first place with 406 points. The men's swimming team racked up 227 points and was third overall after Friday's events. The 14th-ranked Bulldogs finished in first place (302) followed by Minnesota (279), FSU, Georgia Tech (133), NC State (102), Clemson (49), Florida Atlantic (43) and UNC-Willmington (14).

The Seminoles were led by their 200M free relay teams Friday night. Both squads recorded first place finishes for Florida State. The FSU men's team (Maine-Baillie, Ammons, Mashburn and Paulus) posted a time of 1:21.16 and out-paced second place Georgia by 1.5 seconds. The women's 200 free team (Adams, Cech, Bell and Williams) finished with a mark of 1:32.90 and also finished ahead of the second place Bulldogs.

Both squads also recorded first place finishes in the 50 free. The Lady Seminole's Christy Cech (:22.64) beat out two Lady Bulldogs for the top spot in the field. Greg Main-Baillie and Nnamnse Ammons finished 1-2 in the men's 50 free Friday evening. Main-Baillie posted a winning time of 20:38 and Ammons was close behind with a mark of 20:43.

ATHENS, Ga - The Florida State men's and women's swimming and diving teams completed second day action in the Georgia Invitational on the campus of the University of Georgia in Athens. FSU completed day two with two first place finishes, 15 top 5 finishes and seven top 10 finishes. Both squads also ended the day in the top 3 of the team standings.

The woman have compiled 475 points through two days of competition and are currently in third place behind Georgia (889) and Clemson (518) and ahead of NC State (368) and Florida Atlantic (179). The men's swimming and diving team racked up 449 points in two days of competition and was third overall heading into the final day of competition Sunday. The 14th-ranked Bulldogs held on to first place with 709 points followed by Minnesota (703), FSU, Georgia Tech (335), NC State (210), Florida Atlantic (101) and Clemson (99).

Devin Crock recorded one of FSU's two first place finishes with a time of :48.61 in the 100 fly. The Seminoles other first place finisher was diver Chelsie Lerew who recorded a score of 299.55 in the 1M dive.

Florida State also recorded 15 top 5 finishes during day two of competition. The men's 200M medley relay team (Main-Baillie, Betts, Crock, Ammons) finished second in a time of 1:30.19. In the women's 200M fly, FSU's Candice Nethercott took second with a time of :55.65.

The women's 200M medley relay team FSU A (Goodwin, Krynauw, Nethercott, Cech) took third place in a time of 1:44.53 and Joshua Edelman placed third in the 3M dive with 485.50 points. Michelle Sekeres (FSU) also placed third with 249.30 in the 1M dive. Christy Cech's time of 1:48.45 in the 200 free was also good enough for a third place finish. FSU's 800M free relay team (Bell Cech,

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Adams, Lo) took third in a time of 7:40.97 and men's swimmer Justin Betts took third in the 100M breast with a time of :56.31.

The final day of the Georgia Fall Invitational begins at 9:30 a.m. Sunday with prelims and will be followed at 3 p.m. with finals. The teams return to action at the IRCC Relays in Ft. Pierce, Fla. December 21.

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Florida State Men And Women Finish Third At Georgia Invitational

Seminoles continue strong showing in relay events with another first place finish.

ATHENS, Ga. - The Seminole's swimming and diving teams returned home from the Georgia Invitational in Athens with both the men and women finishing third overall against a strong field of competitors. FSU completed day three with two first place finishes, eight top 5 finishes and eight top 10 finishes. For the entire meet, Florida State garnered six first place finishes and 38 top 5 finishes.

Greg Main-Baillie continued to lead the men's team with his third and fourth top finishes in individual and team events. Main-Baillie placed first in the 100 free with a time of :44.37 and teammate Nnamse Ammons came in second with a time of :45.19. Main-Baillie and Ammons were also part of the Noles first place 400 free relay team (Main-Baillie, Ammons, McReynolds, Marshburn) who out-distanced the field with a time of 2:59.62.

The women were lead by the 400 free relay team (Lo, Goodwin, Cucchi, Rasor) who's time of 3:25.38 was good enough for a second place finish. In the women's 100M free, Christy Cech also placed second with a time of :49.36. Three other Lady Noles finished the third day of competition with top 5 finishes. In the 200M back, Amber Goodwin placed fifth with a time of 2:50.82. Kristen Adams' time of :51.59 placed her fifth in the 100M free and Keryn Krynauw placed fifth in the 200M beast with a time of 2:17.81.

The women finished the Georgia Invitational with 682 points finished in third place behind top-ranked Georgia (1251) and Clemson (728) and ahead of NC State (504) and Florida Atlantic (277). The men's swimming and diving team also finished third overall and accumulated 621.5 points through three days of competition. Minnesota (1039) captured first place followed by the 14th-ranked Bulldogs (1031) then FSU, Georgia Tech (491), NC State (338.5), Clemson (170) and Florida Atlantic (128).
