

FSU runners qualify for NCAA

Six meet records fell and four Florida State athletes qualified for next week's NCAA Championships at the fourth annual Seminole Twilight meet on Saturday.

Florida State qualified two members from its men's team and another two from the women's team.

Kenny Smith's 7-foot, 3½-inch mark in the high jump was a new FSU record, and Charlie Carr ran a personal-best 50.87 to qualify in the 400-meter intermediate hurdles.

The women increased their total of NCAA-qualified athletes to 14 with 400-meter hurdler Chris McKay's 59.23 clocking and junior Nancy Rettie's 1,500-meter time of 4:22.39.

Florida's Tanner Cronic qualified in the triple jump with a leap of 53-1½, which also was a meet record.

In the 400, Bud Light's James Rolle broke Walter McCoy's 1981 Mike Long Track record with a 45.34 run while teammates Mel Lattany and Jack McIntosh won the 100 (10.18) and the 800 (1:47.23). Former Auburn sprinter Harvey Glance also set a meet record with a 20.3 clocking in the 200. Florida A&M's Reggie Davis won the 400-meter intermediate hurdles with a personal-best 50.10 and Alphonse Swai set a meet record in the 5,000 meters with a 14:04.75 showing.
