Track athletes make NCAAs

Three members of the Florida State track team qualified for the NCAA Track and Field Championship in competition at the Mt. Sac (Calif.) Invitational.

Rodney Lawson ran 13.50 in 110-meter hurdles to become the first member of the men's team to qualify this year. Patrice Verdon posted a time of 11.43 in 100-meter dash, and Kim Batten ran a 13.31 in the 100-meter hurdles. Batten also set the school record in her event.

Verdon and Batten already qualified as members of FSU's 4x100 relay team, ranked No. 2 in the nation. Trinnette Johnson and Lisa Horton are the other members of the team. They will compete this weekend in the Gatorade Invitational in Gainesville, and then in Jamaica the next week.

Holly Kelly has already qualified in the high jump.
