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■ Three Seminoles and a pair of Lady Seminoles have qualified for the NCAA Indoor Championships set for this weekend in Indianapolis, Indiana.

Pole vaulter **Jeff Bray** was an automatic qualifier after a vault of 17-10 $\frac{1}{2}$ earlier this year. High jumper **Kevin Crist** was a provision qualifier with a best of 7-3. **Shannon Baker**, a starting flanker on football team, met provisional standards in the 55-meter dash at 6.21.

Sheryl Covington will compete in the 55-and 400-meter dash. Covington's 6.85 in the 55-meter dash met automatic standards. **Patrice Verdun**, making her third consecutive trip to the Indoor Championships, met automatic standards in the 200-meter dash with 23.92.
