



FRIDA THOROARDOTTIR, winner Heat 1, women's 3,000 meters

(On why she went out so fast...)

"I just telt good and wanted to improve my time. I didn't know it I'd get a chance to do it tomorrow. I just wanted to make sure today. I thought I would go faster. I usuaually try to run how I feel, so I thought I'd see how it would go. I have nothing to lose."

MOLLY MCClimon, winner Heat 2, women's 3,000 meters

"It was just a tactical race. I just wanted to get qualified as simple as possible." Finish wasn't that simple, thought, with 3-4 girls in the leader pack, including Villanova's Nnenna Lynch, one of the favorites.

CORMAC FINNERTY, winner Heat 1, Men's 3000 Meters
"I could have run slower, but I found myself in the lead. I felt good because I wan't boxed in, and I just wanted to finish in the top four. Guys came up on me at the end, but I held them off to make sure. I feel fine; I'm ready for tomorrow."

RAY APPENHEIMER, winner Heat 2, Men's 3,000 Meters

Took lead with little more than 2 laps to go, then pulled away; "My coach and I felt we wanted to stay off the rail and not get boxed in, otherwise might not make finals. Once I was in front I felt fresh enough...I felt nobody would challenge (for the lead), that they'd be fighting for the spots (to qualify). In the finals, hopefully I can stay with the pack through the 1st 2,000, then we'll see what happens." FYI, his time of 8:03 (something) is a PR

STEFFANIE SMITH, winner Heat 3, Women's 400 Meters
"It will be an indoor PR for me if it holds up (the 53.15 unofficial time). I knew I would have to go because they were taking the top eight times instead of places. I was just running it like a final."

DEON MINOR, def. champ, 2nd in 2nd heat men's 400:

He pulled right hamstring in SW Conference meet, missed a week's practice; injury happened in the 200. "I feel pretty good, it doesn't hurt. I just wanted to make sure I put together a good time." Heat winner was Wes Russell of Clemson.

JILL STAMISON, Winner Heat 1, Women's 800 Semi-Final
"I wanted to take it out fast--about 31--but I went too fast; I think about 29.
On the middle laps I relaxed and then on the last lap I kicked it in. I can go a lot faster tomorrow. It was my goal to win it today. I didn't care about time."

SCOTT PETERS, Winner Heat 1, Men's 800 Meter Semi-Final
"It went a little slow. Just making the finals is the key...top three. We'll see what happens tomorrow."

"It went better than my first race. I hesitated in that one at the gun and had to hurry up and go all out (she won it, too). In both heats I picked up the pace in the middle and accelerated. Tomorrow (the final)? I want to win."

CHERYL TAPLIN, Winner 2nd heat, women's 55 Meter semi-final "The killer race is coming up (her 200 later today). That's the race I'm really worried about. In the first race today (the 55 meters), the starter held us too long in the blocks and everybody had a bad start. The times weren't too good in my heat. In the second round everybody was ready to go. It should be a good final tomorrow."

MICHAEL GREEN, def. champ men's 55m dash and winner of 1st semifinal

"I feel good, but I have to concentrate more on the start. I depend on the 1st 20m to give me the lead (it worked in the prelims and in the semifinal). I feel good and good about my chances of repeating tomorrow."

KAREN GLERUM, winner 1st heat women's mile: She took the lead on backstretch of final lap. "They took it out fast enough and I wasn't worried (about qualifying). I have a good kick and I try to rely on it. I just wanted to make sure I was in the top 3."

MARCEL LAROS, winner 1st heat men's mile semi-final (he came from 2nd place to cross the line first)

I went all out. My coach told me to stay relaxed because I was going up against some top girls. I came out and ran. My parents and relatives and friends are here. (On whether this was her best win) "This is the best. I'm running against lots of schools in the US. I wasn't expecting to win all four races today. I'm really

(On her glasses) "They don't slip or anything. They just stay on one spot."

KEVIN COLEMAN, Winner of Men's Shot Put (Univ. of Nebraska Sr. and winner of last year's competition). (on winning this year) "It feels good." (when compared to last year) "Not as good, I threw farther(last year). The competition was kicking my butt today. I needed competition, but didn't respond to it." (about what he plans to do now) "I'm going to root on my other teammates".

CHRIS NELLOMS, winner men's 200m

"I was determined to be a contender--I wasn't worrying about winning. The victory made it even better, especially after all I've been through... I started picking up the lead in the second turn. I came off the top of the turn so fast I had no form. It (winning) feels so good, I could cry."

(about winning) "It feels good." (about breaking a record) "It's o.k.. I had some pressure because there were so many expactations for me to win. My friend (Ray Doakes the favored high jumper who went out at 2.15, 7-0%) didn't do so well. I saw him sitting over there. (about his win or Doakes loss affecting the team championship) "It won't affect it that much. We have key performers in the other events." (about competition) "The others were closing in on me. I had a good jump (the record breaking 8.33) and put the pressure on the others and off me. It is an indoor PR, but I've jumped 27-9.

JONAH KOECH, winner men's 5,000m, making it 3 times in 4 yrs (he passed up last year to concentrate on Olympics, then failed to make Kenya's team)

"I'm not really in shape. I have some knee and back ailments, and considering that, I'm really happy. This is only my second (indoor) meet; I won the Big 8 conference two weeks ago. It may have looked like an easy win but under the circumstances,






