Meet referee Judy Harrison, of San Jacinto College, Pasadena, Texas, released the following statement:

"Upon reviewing the results of the Women's 5000, it is obvious that competitors ran an extra lap. However, since all runners except Ecke ran the same distance, the order of finish will stand as posted (revised posting). There is no way to determine who was in what position after 25 laps, and some runners made their move on the race last lap and some made their move earlier."

Note: Smathers ran 5200 meters but an automatic time was not recorded for her.

COURTNEY BABCOCK, junior from Michigan, placed 4th after leading during the 4th Km and momentarily stepped off the track and lost the lead: "I don't think I got bumped. I was just too close to the rail and stepped on it a couple of times and couldn't regain my balance. So I stepped off the track."

HOLLY HYCHE, INDIANA STATE, winner of the women's 200 meters with a meet record time (22.90) "I went into this race just wanting to p.r. I did that and I'm extremely happy. My coach told me just to run my own race. At the start I was just trying to stay with Flirtisha (Harris of Seton Hall) because she's so fast. Then I just tried to focus as I did in the prelims, and started accelerating on the straightaway."

John GODINA, junior at UCLA winner of Shot put at 20.03/65-8 3/4:
"That was a life time best. I threw it on my first attempt. I had a lifetime best last weekend, so I thought that I might have a good throw tonight, too. I was in a good groove. After I got into the meet, I really got into it. A few weeks ago, I wasn't sure how I might do because I over-extended the middle finger on my throwing hand. It was sore."

CHRIS NELLOMS, OHIO STATE, defending his 200-meter title: "I ran the whole turn with a knot in my hamstring. I couldn't turn over. I was just trying to keep my knees in front of me and hold my form. I didn't feel right all day. I know I could've broken the record: I wasn't tired, I wasn't tight. I ran 20.60 with a knotted hamstring."

DIONNE ROSE, MIDDLE TENNESSEE STATE, winner of the women's 55 meter hurdles:
I tried to get out fast...as fast as I could. My start was not that good, but I was able to push it and come through clean. I feel really good about it. Mental toughness played a key role, because of my hurt thigh, but I mentally focused and came out on top.

ROBERT FOSTER, senior at -Fresno state won 55m hurdles:
"It felt good. The start wasn't great. I wasn't leading until about the third hurdle. I kept accelerating and kept pressing to the tape. My race over the hurdles was great. I didn't hit any hurdles. Usually when that happens, I run fast

JASON BUNSTON, ARKANSAS, winner of the men's 5000 meters: "I wanted to run a fast time tonight, but when the Winthrop guy took it out real hard I decided to hold back. I played lazy [with James Power] until the last 500m and then took off. I could see him on the scoreboard and he was right on my butt."

On why no Arkansas runners entered the 3000: "It's the first time in a long time we've had no one in the 3000. But I'm glad because if we had put anyone in it would've been me!"

ERICK WALDER, two-time defending indoor champ (26-3½; 27-4): won at 27-8/8.43
"I came into the meet wanting to break Carl Lewis' record (27-10). But I got that string of 26-11 jumps and it broke my concentration. I started pushing a little too much in the finals and then finally go re-focused for my final jump."

DAPHNIE SAUNDERS, LOUISIANA STATE, winner of the women's long jump with a meet record: On her reaction to Dedra Davis' meet record in the first flight: "It was the biggest pressure of my life. Naturally it was going to motivate me."

"I think the problem I have with this runway is that it's too fast. But I'm not complaining. I won. The competition took 3½ hours, but it shouldn't affect me for the triple jump tomorrow."

RANDY JENKINS, TENNESSEE, winner of the men's high jump with a leap of 7-7:
"It really makes coming back for another year of eligibility worth it. I came here last year and no-heighted, so to come back this season and win it all is great to. It felt good."
