FLORIDA STATE TO HOST LAST HOME TRACK MEET OF THE SEASON

Tallahassee, FL -- FSU will host the Seminole Twilight meet this Saturday, May 11, at Mike Long Track. Field events will begin at 2:00 p.m. with the women's hammer throw and running events at 6:20 p.m. with the 4X100 meter relay. Admission is free to the public. Georgia Tech, Miami, UCF, Auburn and several other schools are scheduled to compete.

Several Seminole athletes will aim to improve their NCAA Outdoor qualifying marks at the last home meet of the year.

Senior All-American Jonathan Carter ranks as one of the nation's top sprinters. Carter's 200 meter time currently ranks fourth in the country and his 100 meter dash mark is eighth. The Ft. Lauderdale native's respective times, 10.17 (100M) and 20.40 (200M), are both automatic qualifying times for the NCAA Outdoor Championships to be held in Eugene, Oregon from May 29 - June 1. Carter has also been invited to the Olympic Trials.

Phillip Riley is also an automatic qualifier for the NCAA's. The All-American hurdler holds the third fastest national time in the 110 meter hurdles with a mark of 13.48. Riley clocked the career-best time while winning the ACC Championship in the event. The Philadelphia Eagles draftee has two national championships under his belt already, one with the 1993 Seminole football team and an individual title in last year's 55M NCAA hurdle Championship.

The women's 4X400 meter relay team has the fastest national time in the event at 3:32.70. The team (Yashiva Edwards, Maria Embon, Erica Shepard and Sophia Danvers) finished second at this year's NCAA Indoor Championship. The 3:32.70 was clocked at last weekend's Seminole Challenge when the Lady Seminoles finished just ahead of the Florida Gators who finished with the second fastest national time of 3:32.90.

FSU also has many provisional qualifiers including: Phillip Riley - 100M, Warrick Dunn - 100M, Andrea Colombo - 100M, 4X100M relay (Patrick Hayes, Dunn, Colombo, Carter), Justin Johnston - Javelin, Casey Custer - 100M, 200M, Sophia Danvers - 400M, Yashiva Edwards - 400M, Maria Embon - 400M, Erica Shepard - 800M, Kristen Thorne - 100M hurdles, Rikke Ronholt - 400M hurdles, Petena Moultrie - Triple Jump, Shannon Cook - Shot Put, Hammer.

FSU TRACK POSTS IMPRESSIVE TIMES AT SEMINOLE TWILIGHT

Tallahassee, FL -- Florida State hosted the last home meet of the year at Mike Long Track Saturday evening. For Senior All-Americans Jonathan Carter and Phillip Riley it was their last meet at Mike Long Track as a Seminole.

Jonathan Carter did not disappoint as he finished first in the 100 meter dash. Carter, who has already automatically qualified for the NCAA's, recorded a time of 10.28. The senior added a second place finish in the 200M (21.25) and also ran on the first place 4X100 meter relay team (40.07).

Placing second in the 100 meters behind Carter was Great Britain's Jonathan Edwards with a time of 10.48. Edwards is currently training for the Olympics and is the world record holder in the triple jump, the only athlete to ever jump over 60 feet.

Phillip Riley took top honors in the 110 meter high hurdles with a time 13.62, an automatic NCAA qualifying mark. Riley recorded a time of 13.48 earlier in the outdoor season. The senior two-sport athlete picked up his second first place finish of the evening as a part of the 4X100M relay team.

In the javelin, All-American Justin Johnston recorded his best throw of the season. His toss of 70 meters (229'8") was good for first place and is another NCAA provisional mark.

The women had several performers improve their NCAA provisional marks including Erica Shepard in the 800 meters. Shepard clocked in at 2:05.97 in a first place effort.


Junior Yashiva Edwards brought home a first place in the 200 meters with a provisional time of 23.46. Edwards also had a provisional mark in the 400 meters where she finished second (53.37).

Sophia Danvers ran an impressive 53.02 in the 400M to edge out Edwards. Danvers, Edwards, Shepard and Embon make up the 4X400M relay team that had the fastest time in the nation coming into the weekend. The 4X400M team did not run.

Also finishing first for the Lady Seminoles were Shannon Cook in the shot put (47'11.25"), Laura Goens in the javelin (114'11") and Rikke Ronholt in the 400M hurdles (58.73).

Missing from the Seminole Twilight lineup was Junior Warrick Dunn, a provisional qualifier in the 100M and 4X100M. The Heisman hopeful is in Phoenix, AZ with the Playboy All-America Football Team.
