FSU RELAYS BEGIN WITH DECATHLON AND HEPTATHLON

TALLAHASSEE, FL -- In rainy conditions at Mike Long Track, the Florida State Relays completed the first half of the decathlon and heptathlon competitions this afternoon. A pair of Tallahassee athletes lead the way for FSU.

Freshman Chinette Johnson (Lincoln HS) stands in first place after day one with a point total of 2972 in the heptathlon. Tomorrow, Johnson will attempt to hold her lead with the long jump, javelin and 800m.

On the men's side, Sophomore Darius Jones (Godby HS) finished the first day in second place in the decathlon with 3688 points with the 110m hurdles, discus, pole vault, javelin and 1500m remaining. Todd Doughty (unattached) leads the decathlon with 3810 points.

Action continues tomorrow in Tallahassee with the decathlon starting at 10:00 a.m. and the heptathlon at 10:30 a.m. Field events will start tomorrow at 9:00 a.m. with the men's hammer. Friday's field events begin at 9:00 a.m. with running events at 11:30 a.m. with Saturday's field events starting at 10:00 a.m. and running events at 12:00 p.m. (last event @ 4:55 p.m.). Admission is free to the public.

FSU RELAYS WRAP UP FINAL DAY OF ACTION

TALLAHASSEE, FL -- Florida State hosted the final day of the FSU Relays today at Mike Long Track. The Seminoles added several more first place finishes before action concluded late this afternoon.

In the women's 100m dash, two current Lady Seminoles were narrowly beaten by a former FSU great. Olympic silver medalist and current 400m hurdle world record holder Kim Batten took first place in 11.74 seconds with freshman Teresa Bundy placing second at 11.77 and sophomore Tonya Carter third at 11.82. Bundy and Carter were also members of the women's 4x100m relay team that won an FSU Relays title with a time of 45.61.

The men's 4x100m relay team of Patrick Hayes, Travis Minor, Laveranues Coles and Tavaris Spradley also finished first as they clocked in at 40.51, edging out the Florida team who ran second at 40.74. Coles and Minor, starters on the FSU football team at wide receiver and tailback, were excused from this morning's scrimmage for the meet.

The men grabbed three of the top four spots in the discus as the Seminoles went 2-3-4. Jody Lawrence was second with a toss of 178-7 with Donald Heaven (who also starts for the football team at offensive guard) and Brad Hess checking in at 159-6 and 157-3, respectively. Darius Jones added a second place finish in the high jump at 6-8.75 (he had fewer attempts than teammate Chris Osborn who had the same mark and placed third) and a third place effort in the long jump with a mark of 22-1.

FSU'S CHINETTE JOHNSON WINS FSU RELAYS HEPTATHLON TITLE

TALLAHASSEE, FL -- Florida State freshman Chinette Johnson won the heptathlon this afternoon as rain continued at the FSU Relays. The Tallahassee native finished with a point total of 5010, just missing an NCAA provisional qualifying mark (5075).

In the decathlon, FSU's Darius Jones placed fourth overall with 6810 points. Another Seminole, Dore Louis took seventh with 6337 points. Todd Daughy (unattached) won the event with 7337 points.

Field events also began today with Florida State taking first place in all four held this afternoon. Lakeisha Mose won the FSU Relays title in the women's hammer with a mark of 160-11 and Jody Lawrence won the men's hammer at 170-3. Donald Heaven was first in the Div. II men's shot put (48-9.50) and Lawrence was first in the Div. II men's discus (173-3). Only one event, the women's Div. I javelin, had to postponed until tomorrow afternoon because of the weather.

The women's discus is the first field event tomorrow morning at 9:00 a.m. and the running events start at 11:30 a.m. with the women's 100m hurdle trials. FSU TRACK RELAYS CONTINUE AT MIKE LONG TRACK

TALLAHASSEE, FL--The FSU Relays concluded their third day of competition at the Mike Long Track on the campus of Florida State University today.

The women's team grabbed top honors in the high jump and hammer throw. Senior Christine Daniels won the high jump event with a height of 5-07, beating teammate Michaela Steele. Lakeisha Mose won the hammer throw with a distance of 49.06, defeating Melissa York of Northern Iowa by more than two meters. Zuzette Mullings of Florida State competed in three individual events today. Mullings, a sophomore from Ellicott City, MD, finished third in the long jump (5.82m), second in the triple jump (11.81m) and fifth in the 100m dash (11.95).

The women's 4X100m relay team finished in second place .79 seconds behind Florida A&M University, while the 4X400 M relay finished in fourth place.

The only women's athlete to achieve a NCAA provisional mark was Kerine Black of South Florida. Black had a triple jump of 12.60m.

The men's team was led by a pair of throwers in today's competition. Sophomore Donald Heaven captured the Division II shot put with a throw of 14.87m. Joseph Lawrence captured the Division I hammer throw (51.90m) and also captured the Division II discus throw (52.80m). Brad Hess finished second in the hammer throw, 5.18m behind teammate Lawrence.

The distance runners were led by Aaron Sheer. Sheer finished in seventh place (14:46.55) in the 5,000m run. The 4X200m relay team finished in second place with a time of 1:24.04.

Travis Minor ran the second fastest 100m time (10.55) in heat qualifying for tomorrow's 100m final. The finals of the 100m dash will be at 2:35 p.m. on Saturday.

The completion of the FSU Relays will take place all day tomorrow at the Mike Long Track and is free to the public.

FSU ATHLETES WRAP UP COMPETITION AT FLORIDA RELAYS

GAINESVILLE, FL -- The FSU track and field team continued their outdoor season as they traveled to Gainesville for the 1998 Coca-Cola Florida Relays at Percy Beard Stadium.

All-American Zuzette Mullings brought home a first place finish in the collegiate women's 100m dash with a time of 11.85 to pace the Lady Seminoles. Mullings added a fourth place effort in the women's invitational triple jump (40-9) and a sixth place finish in the women's invitational long jump (19-4.75).

Sophomore Shannon Steele had a solid day in both the women's collegiate high jump and javelin. Steele placed second in the high jump with a mark of 5-4.25 and eighth in the javelin at 135-10.

On the men's side, FSU had four of the top 16 finishers in the collegiate 100m dash. Two-sport standouts Travis Minor and Germaine Stringer were sixth (10.71) and eighth (10.72), respectively, while Tavaris Spradley and Patrick Hayes placed 14th (10.82) and 16th (10.83). Laveranues Coles added a 24th place effort (10.98) in a men's 100m field of over 50 runners.

Also scoring well for the men were Jason Dean and Barnard Francis. Dean pole vaulted 15-9.25 to finish fourth while Francis triple jumped 47-11.25 to take second among collegiate athletes.

Other FSU athletes among the top ten: Teresa Bundy - 100m (6th - 12.00), Ayana Townsend - 100m hurdles (ninth - 14.59), 400m hurdles (eighth - 1:02.66), Fiona Norwood - 40m hurdles (fifth - 1:02.31), women's 4x400m relay (third - 3:43.87), men's 4x400m relay (fourth - 3:13.16), Michaela Steele - high jump (sixth - 5-2.25), Chinette Johnson - triple jump (sixth - 38-6.75), Chris Osborn - high jump (seventh - 6-7), Donald Heaven - shot put (sixth - 49-3.50), Brad Hess - discus (10th - 152-8), Lakeisha Mose - inv. shot put (seventh - 44-4.25), Darius Jones - inv. high jump (sixth - 6-8.75), Jody Lawrence - inv. discus (sixth - 168-0).

The outdoor season continues next weekend as both squads travel to Atlanta for the Georgia Tech Invitational.
