### FSU TRACK TEAMS PLACE FOURTH AT ACC INDOORS

FEBRUARY 20, 1999

BLACKSBURG, VA -- The Florida State men's and women's track and field teams both placed fourth overall for the second consecutive year at the ACC Indoor Championships. Clemson took the men's title while North Carolina came out on top in women's competition.

Sophomore Jason Dean won the ACC pole vault title with an NCAA provisional qualifying mark of 17-4.50. It was a new collegiate best vault for the Clearwater, FL native. Tallahassee's Darius Jones won the men's long jump at 24-8.25. Jones also added fifth place points in the pole vault (15-7) and seventh place points in the triple jump (45-0.75). The third Seminole to record an ACC Championship was Jody Lawrence in the weight throw with an NCAA provisional toss of 65-2.25, which established a new ACC record in the event. Lawrence, a junior from Cocoa, FL, also placed sixth in the shot put (50-4.50).

Freshman Mario Lowe was impressive as well, triple jumping an NCAA provisional 51-5 to earn All-ACC honors. Zyris Hill contributed points in two events with a third in the long jump (24-7.25) and a sixth in the 400m (47.89).

On the women's side, Laura Gerber and the 4x400m relay team picked up ACC titles. As a true freshman, Gerber won the 800m with a time of 2:12.59 and ran on the winning 4x400m relay team with Chinette Johnson, Fiona Norwood and Samantha George that crossed the finish line first in 3:42.24.

Tonya Carter also had a strong showing for the Lady Seminoles. The junior finished second in the 60m dash in 7.36 (NCAA provisional time) and placed third in the 200m in 24.11. Two newcomers recorded second place efforts as freshman Makiba Batten had a shot put of 46-6.25 and George, a junior transfer, ran 53.72 in the 400m.

## NORTH CAROLINA LEADS ACC MEN'S INDOOR TRACK AND FIELD CHAMPIONSHIPS AFTER FIRST DAY OF COMPETITION

February 19, 1999

BLACKSBURG, VA—North Carolina leads the ACC Men's Indoor Track and Field Championships with 41 points after Friday's competition. Florida State is second with 27 points, N.C. State is third with 24 points, and Clemson is fourth with 19 points.

In the field event finals held on Friday, North Carolina took the top three positions in the shot put. Senior Allen Bradd successfully defended his championship with a mark of 57'1", and sophomore Ian Douglas placed second at 54'7 1/2". Sophomore James Wagstaff placed third for the Tar Heels with a throw of 54'0". In the long jump competition, freshman Darius Jones of Florida State placed first with a mark of 24'8 1/4", and North Carolina freshman Marcus O'Neal was second with a jump of 24'7 1/4".

The finals of the 5,000m and the distance medley relay were held Friday evening. Chan Pons of N.C. State won the 5,000m with a provisional qualifying time of 14:07.96, while senior Nolan Swanson of Wake Forest was second at 14:20.75. The N.C. State team of Abdul Alzindani, Tyrone Dozier, Robbie Howell and Chris Dugan won the distance medley relay in 9:54.23, just .13 off the ACC record. Florida State's team of Aaron Scheer, Kenyon Langston, Patrick Brett and Michael Maier was second with a time of 10:00.64. The top two finishers in the finals of all events earn all-ACC honors.

The preliminaries of several running events were completed during Friday's competition. Clemson sophomore Sultan Tucker led all runners in the 60m hurdles with a provisional qualifying time of 7.80, and Butch McClelland of N.C. State was second at 7.94. In the 60m, Clemson junior Shawn Crawford led all qualifiers with a provisional qualifying time of 6.71, and North Carolina's Marcus O'Neal had the second-fastest qualifying time at 6.79.

Clemson placed five runners in the finals of the 200m, including Crawford, who ran an NCAA Automatic Qualifying time of 20.80. North Carolina senior Dominic Demeritte had the second-fastest finish with a provisional time of 21.07. In the 400m, Clemson freshman Ato Modibo had the fastest qualifying time with a provisional qualifying time of 46.88, and Georgia Tech's Jonas Motiejunas was second with a time of 47.28.

Duke junior Kyle Leonard led all qualifiers in the 800m (1:53.03), and Virginia senior Damond Cromer turned in the second-fastest qualifying time at 1:53.15. In the mile run, Aaron Saft of N.C. State had the fastest qualifying time at 4:11.64, while Clemson senior Esteban Diaz was second with a time of 4:15.93.

Field event competition begins Saturday at 10 a.m., and the finals of the running events will commence at 1 p.m.

## CLEMSON WINS ACC MEN'S INDOOR TRACK & FIELD CHAMPIONSHIP February 20, 1999

BLACKSBURG, VA - The Clemson men's track team won the ACC Indoor Track and Field championship with 162 points Saturday in Blacksburg. The win was the Tigers' third-straight and their seventh in the 1990s. Clemson has won nine ACC Indoor Championships overall and eight under head coach Bob Pollock. North Carolina placed second with 112.50 points, and N.C. State was third with 108 points. Meet records were set in the 60m hurdles, 3000m and the weight throw on Saturday.

"It's a tremendous feeling winning the 1999 championship and even more to have a three-peat," said Pollock following the win. "I am really proud of our guys. This meet probably this has to go down as one of the best track performances in the history of Clemson and the ACC. We won nine out of 16 events overall and ended up with 12 ACC Champions, including the four members of our relay team. This is probably one of the greatest ACC performances in Clemson's history. I have to give credit to my assistants, Ralph White and Aaron James, for making sure we were well-prepared for the meet. Individually we had several national qualifiers, including Shawn Crawford in the 60m and the 200m, Sultan Tucker in the 60m hurdles, Ato Modibo in the 400m and our 4x400m relay team. In the field events Doug Ameigh qualified in the high jump and Bryan Williams in the triple jump."

Clemson posted wins in seven of eight running events on Saturday. Tiger junior Shawn Crawford won the 60m for the second consecutive season, with a time of 6.77, followed by Reggie Austin at 6.81. Clemson sophomore Sultan Tucker won the 60m hurdles, tying the ACC record with a time of 7.79, and Butch McClelland of N.C. State was second at 7.90.

Crawford also won the ACC Championship in the 200m, with an NCAA automatic qualifying time of 20.81. North Carolina's Dominic Demeritte placed second with a provisional qualifying time of 21.17. In the 400m, Clemson freshman Ato Modibo won the championship with an NCAA automatic qualifying time of 46.00. Georgia Tech's Jonas Motiejunas was second with a provisional qualifying time of 46.79.

Clemson senior Davidson Gill won the 800m in 1:52.46, and junior Kyle Leonard of Duke was second at 1:52.88. In the mile competition Tiger senior Esteban Diaz won the title with a time of 4:10.20, followed by Aaron Saft of N.C. State at 4:11.20. In the 3,000m, senior Nolan Swanson of Wake Forest posted a time of 8:03.50 for the win, setting a new ACC record. Chan Pons of N.C. State came in second with a time of 8:05.53.

The Tiger 4x400m relay team of Allen, Franklin, Gill and Modibo won the championship with a provisional qualifying time of 3:09.66, followed by Georgia Tech's team of Michael Johnson, Tosi Tomori, Aaron Sink and Motiejunas with a time of 3:11.99.

In the field events on Saturday, Florida State junior Joseph Lawrence set a new ACC record with a mark of 65'2 1/4". North Carolina senior Allen Bradd was second at 56'5 3/4". Clemson freshman Doug Ameigh won the high jump with a provisional qualifying jump of 7'1 1/2", his highest of the season. Brandon Brown of N.C. State was second at 7'1/4".

Clemson junior Bryan Williams won the triple jump with a provisional qualifying mark of 52'5 1/4", followed by freshman Mario Lowe of Florida State with a provisional jump of 51'5". Sophomore Jason Dean of Florida State won the pole vault competition with a provisional qualifying jump of 17'4 1/2", while freshman Brent Callaway of North Carolina was second with a mark of 16'5 1/2".

The top two athletes in each event earn all-ACC honors. Meet MVP, Coach and Freshman of the Year will be announced next week.

## NORTH CAROLINA WOMEN WIN ACC INDOOR TRACK & FIELD CHAMPIONSHIP Gamble wins third-straight triple jump title, sets ACC record February 20, 1999

BLACKSBURG, VA—The North Carolina women's track and field team won the ACC Indoor Track & Field Championship Saturday in Blacksburg. The Tar Heels scored 121 points for the win, their seventh-straight championship, and their ninth in the 1990s. The win was North Carolina's 11th overall and under head coach Dennis Craddock. Clemson finished second with 100 points, and Georgia Tech was third with 91 points.

Tar Heel senior Nicole Gamble won her third-straight ACC Championship in the triple jump, becoming only the seventh athlete in the history of the ACC to win three-consecutive titles. Gamble set a new ACC record with a mark of 44'8 1/4" for the win. North Carolina senior LaShonda Christopher was second with a provisional mark of 42'5 1/4", and Tar Heel junior DeAnne Davis was third with a provisional mark of 41'10 1/2". In the weight throw competition held Saturday, Maryland freshman Ruth Kura placed first with a throw of 56'8 1/2", and Virginia senior Ann Crouse was second at 55'7 1/2".

"Someone asked me if winning the seventh was as sweet as the first, and yes it is," said Craddock following the presentation of the championship trophy. "I thought we would have a great battle from Clemson coming in, and they certainly did give us a great run. We had a little adversity with some of our people going down early this year with injuries, so we weren't at full strength. Our people that were at full strength rose to the occasion; they just wanted to win. Again, I'm very proud of them."

In the running events on Saturday, Georgia Tech senior Andria King won the 60m and 60m hurdles, turning in an automatic qualifying times in both events. In the 60m, King posted a 7.26, followed by Florida State junior Tonya Carter with a provisional time of 7.36. In the hurdles, King ran a time of 8.16, followed by Clemson senior Nikkie Bouyer with a provisional time of 8.30.

Clemson junior Shekera Weston won the 200m and 400m, recording provisional qualifying times in both events. Weston recorded a time of 23.62 in the 200m, followed by North Carolina sophomore Crystal Cox with a provisional time of 23.95. Weston won the 400m in 53.36, and in second place was junior Samantha George of Florida State with a provisional time of 53.72.

Florida State freshman Laura Gerber won the 800m in 2:12.69, and sophomore Sara Pardue of Georgia Tech posted the second-fastest time at 2:13.60. In the mile run, Wake Forest junior Jill Snyder won with a time of 4:54.26, followed by Georgia Tech junior Becky Megesi at 4:54.74. Georgia Tech senior Linda Lisska took the title in the 3,000m, posting a time of 9:53.01, while sophomore Jennifer Owens of Virginia was second at 9:56.82.

The Florida State 4x400m relay team of Chinette Johnson, Fiona Norwood, Gerber and George placed first with a time of 3:42.24, and Georgia Tech's 4x400m relay team of Nadia Johnson, King, Coquese Renfroe and Tiffany Giles was second with a time of 3:44.15
