## Shorter trips Tribe twice

Frequent turnovers, coupled with the inability to latch onto a higher percentage of rebounds, caused Florida State's women's basketball team to drop a weekend doubleheader to visiting Shorter College of Rome, Ga.

Shorter topped the Lady Seminoles 65-52 Friday night, largely because of a 55-37 rebound verdict in the Georgians' favor.

Marlene Graham paced FSU with 20 points, while Emma Colquitt pulled down 13 rebounds. Paula Dean tied Graham's point total for the winners.

Saturday afternoon the Lady Seminoles, plagued by

33 turnovers, lost 78-63. However, FSU was still in the game until the final nine minutes when top gun Marlene Graham, with 15 points, fouled out.

Shorter led at halftime by only four, 39-35.

Shorter's Wanda Green led all scorers in the Saturday contest with 24 points. Paula Dean added 19.

Lady Seminole Coach Millie Usher felt both games were closer than the final scores and "could have gone either way."

She pointed out that FSU had a better field goal percentage in both games.
