LADY SEMINOLES SEARCHING FOR FIRST ACC WIN

TALLAHASSEE -- The Florida State women's basketball team, 4-9 overall and 0-2 in the ACC, are looking to snap a six-game skid as the Lady Seminoles travel to Clemson, S.C. for a noon-matchup on Sunday, Jan. 8 with the Clemson Lady Tigers. Clemson is 10-3 overall and 0-1 in league play.

Both Florida State and Clemson will be trying for their first win in ACC competition this season. The Lady Seminoles lost to Duke, 68-84, back in December and dropped a 77-52 decision to #4-ranked North Carolina on Wednesday. However, in that contest, the final score was not indicative of the game. FSU hung tough with the defending national champion Tar Heels and trailed by just six with 10 minutes to play. Leading by just 10 at the 4:08 mark, UNC went on a 15-2 run in the game's final minutes to take the decisive victory. Despite the loss, 'Noles' coach Marynell Meadors was pleased with her team's play.

"This was somewhat of a moral victory for us," Meadors said. "Take the last five minutes of the game away and I think our players would feel better about themselves right now. This was one of our better performances, along with the Florida and Texas Tech games. We seem to get up for the big teams. Overall, I thought we had a good game plan and we executed extremely well. We did everything we wanted to do, but should have shot the ball better. We missed a lot of layups."

Clemson's lone ACC loss came to the hands of 11th-ranked Virginia (76-67). The game was played at Clemson -- a place that is difficult for opponents, according to Meadors.

"Clemson is a very difficult place to play," Meadors says. "They (the Lady Tigers) are very good at home. The team is well-coached and are solid from top to bottom. We'll have to do a very good job recognizing their defenses, because they run multiple defense as well as multiple offenses. There's a lot of things going on in their game plan."

The Lady Tigers have three players averaging in double figures in senior guard Tara Saunooke (18.3), sophomore forward Laura Cottrell (14.7) and junior guard Stephanie Ridgeway (11.8).

away and sealed the game with a 12-0 run to take a 72-50 lead with less than two minutes left.

Tanisha Rickman led Florida State with 13 points, while Lysa Moorefield and Carla Williams scored 12 apiece.

LADY SEMINOLES LOSE A HEARTBREAKER

CLEMSON, S.C. -- Despite a career-high 18 points from freshman forward Latrice McLin, the Lady Seminoles lost, 68-72, to ACC-foe Clemson at Littlejohn Coliseum, Sunday afternoon. Florida State falls to 4-10 and 0-3 in ACC play while the Lady Tigers improve to 11-3 overall and even things up with a 1-1 record in the league.

The Lady Seminole got off to a slow start and found themselves down 8-0, until freshman Tanisha Rickman hit two free throws at the 17:24 mark. Clemson built a lead of 12-2 before Florida State finally got things going. The Lady Seminole were able to cut the Clemson lead to just three at 17-14 with just over 10 minutes to play in the first half, but could get no closer and went into the locker room down, 33-25. Clemson's biggest lead was 11 points (29-18) at the five minute mark.

In the second half, Florida State fell behind by 10 twice early, but then went to work. Down 29-39, the Lady Seminoles ran off six straight points to pull within four at 35-39 with 16:46 to go and soon found themselves tied at 43 at the 12:42 mark. The game remained close when with the score 51-50 at the 6:07 mark, Clemson went on a 13-3 run over the next three in a half minutes and took a commanding, 64-53 lead. But Florida State did not back down and went on an 11-2 run of their own and to get within two at 66-64 with 54 second remaining. But Clemson made its free throws in the final minute and despite a three-pointer at the buzzer, the Lady Seminoles fell.

Florida State connected on seven three-pointers for the game. In fact, four of their last six field goals were treys. FSU coach Marynell Meadors was proud of her team's performance.

"I am so proud of our team," Meadors said. "Three weeks, two weeks, a week ago, we could have lost this game by a lot of points. We had the opportunity to win this game and we haven't been in that position late very much this season. We showed a lot of poise, maturity and confidence in our game. I'm really pleased with this performance and I couldn't be more proud of them. Our shot selection was outstanding and we just did a lot of positive things."

All 10 players saw action and all 10 players scored. Most notably, freshman guard Aletha Penn came in and provided the team with solid play.

"Aletha cam off the bench and provided valuable playing time," Meadors said. "Everybody made contributions today."
