LADY SEMINOLES FALL AT NORTH CAROLINA STATE

RALEIGH, N.C. -- The North Carolina State Wolfpack jumped out to an early 17-4 lead against the Florida State women's basketball team and never looked back as they handed the Lady Seminoles a 91-68 loss, Wednesday night at Reynolds Coliseum. It was the eighth consecutive loss for the Lady Seminoles, who fall to a 4-11 overall record and a 0-4 ACC start.

The Wolfpack shot an amazing 59 percent (36-61), including 9-of-14 (64%) from three-point land, for the game and led 47-28 at the halftime break. The Lady Seminoles cut the lead to 16 at 57-41 with 14:13 remaining but could get no closer and trailed by as many as 30 at one point in the contest. Five players tallied double figures for NC State with Tammy Gibson leading the attack with a game-high 21 points.

"We just failed to execute defensively and we failed to execute our game plan," FSU coach Marynell Meadors said. "They (NC State) shot well, but we helped them shoot well. We left them open for too many shots. They definitely had their inside-outside game going."

FSU's Allison Peercy led all Lady Seminole scorers with 18 points while Katina Cobbins scored 11 points and grabbed a team-high eight boards. FSU's leading scorer, freshman Tanisha Rickman, who is suffering from shin splints, played just eight minutes in the game. Junior Anja Pedersen came in late in the second half and hit three straight three-pointers for Florida State.

"Offensively, we just failed to make adjustments and didn't score," Meadors said. "We didn't have our inside-outside combination like we have had in the past couple games. (Allison) Peercy gave us as good an effort as she can give us and gave everything she had, but we had poor team effort and you're not going to be successful in this league with that."

Florida State will host Maryland on Saturday, Jan. 14 at Tully Gym. Tipoff is 7 p.m.

Rediscovered shooting touch leads Pack to rout of Seminoles

RALEIGH — N.C. State coach Kay Yow's eyes brightened as she read senior guard Tammy Gibson's statistics after the Wolfpack's 91-68 rout of Florida State on Wednesday night.

Seven-of-11 from the field, 4-of-7 on three-point attempts, 21 points.

"Now that's my vision of Tammy Gibson, about 20 points every night," said Yow, whose team is 7-5 overall and 2-2 in the ACC.

Such nights were common for Gibson two years ago when she averaged 20.3 points while earning second-team All-ACC honors. Gibson was scoring 17.2 points per game last season when she tore a knee ligament in the Pack's fifth game and took a medical redshirt.

Gibson returned wearing a leg brace this season and scored 20 points once in the Pack's first 11 games. Her average fell to 13.5 points per game, and her 38 percent shooting easily was the worst of her career.

That percentage fell further after Gibson sprained a middle finger two weeks ago. Playing with her right index and middle fingers taped together, Gibson maintained her 13-point scoring average but made just 34 percent of her shots.

Finally, after Gibson missed 13 of 19 shots in an 81-73 loss to Virginia on Saturday, Yow decided to make a change.

"I asked her to take the tape off," Yow said. "I rebounded for her after practice Tuesday, and she started with free throws and then moved out to three-pointers. She made a lot of them. I said 'Tammy, they're going down. Want to try going without the tape?'"

Gibson played with free fingers against the Seminoles but said her shot didn't feel any different. The results were. Gibson made three of five three-point attempts in the first half and scored 12 points. She hit 3-of-4 from the field in the second half, including a couple of tough shots in traffic.

"I shot better, but I can't really compare myself to two years ago," Gibson said. "My overall game is not like it was."

During the first 10 minutes of Wednesday's game, the sparse Reynolds Coliseum crowd got a vision of the type of team Yow would like the Pack to be. State scored on 10 of its first 15 possessions and led 27-9 when point guard Jennifer Howard hit a three-pointer with 10:35 left in the first half.

The Pack hit 11 of 16 field-goal attempts in that run and shot 62 percent — 5-of-7 from three-point range — in building a 47-28 half-time lead. Florida State (4-11, 0-4) missed 12 of its first 18 shots and made 33 percent for the half.

State built the lead to 30 points in the second half. Freshman Erin Young, who had 10 points, banked in a 30-footer with four-tenths of a second left to finish the scoring.
