FLORIDA STATE WOMEN'S BASKETBALL POSTGAME STORY

FSU WOMEN'S BASKETBALL: FOR IMMEDIATE RELEASE -- Feb. 13, 1995

FLORIDA STATE DOWNS FLORIDA ATLANTIC

TALLAHASSEE -- The Florida State women's basketball team improved its record to 7-18 with a 69-55 victory over Florida Atlantic Monday night at Tully Gymnasium. The win betters the team's total wins (six) from a year ago and also breaks a five-game losing streak for the Lady 'Noles. With the loss, Florida Atlantic drops to 8-13 on the season.

Florida State never trailed in the contest and led by as many as 16 points before going into the lockerroom with a 40-25 advantage. The second half was much of the same as the Lady Seminoles would not allow the Owls to get any closer than 12 points and led by as many as 20 with just over three minutes to play.

FSU's Carla Williams led all scorers with 17 points while Lysa Moorefield recorded her first career "double-double" with 11 points and a game-high 10 rebounds. Allison Peercy also tallied double figures for the sixth straight game. All nine FSU players who dressed scored in the contest. Most notably was the performance of freshman Wendy Hampton who scored nine points in 19 minutes off the bench. The forward also grabbed four rebounds and had two steals in the effort. Junior Katina Cobbins was sidelined due to a sore shoulder.

"A win is a win is a win," FSU coach Marynell Meadors said smiling. "No matter how you look at it, it's a 'W'. Any win is a great win right now. It helps take the pressure off the team a little bit. We really came out of the gate ready to play and that's something we haven't done lately. That was good to see."

Florida State outrebounded FAU, 43-39, and held the Owls to 30 percent shooting from the field.

"Our defense was good tonight," Meadors said. "One of our goals was to hold them to 25 points or under in the first half, and we did that."

The Lady Seminoles hit the road for a three-game stretch away from Tully Gymnasium. FSU will play at Maryland on Thursday, Feb. 16 at 7:30 p.m., to kick off the first of four games in seven days.
