Maryland wins first national title in school history

The second-seeded Terrapins knocked off No. 1 seeds North Carolina and Duke en route to their first national title ... Maryland defeated North Carolina in the national semifinal, 81-70, then defeated the Blue Devils in overtime in the championship game, 78-75. Duke, Maryland and North Carolina all advanced to the Final Four, marking the first time one conference has sent three teams to the same Final Four ... Nine ACC teams earn post-season bids - including seven NCAA Tournament bids, marking the second-straight year the ACC has received seven NCAA bids ... North Carolina and Duke both earned No. 1 seeds, marking the first time the ACC has had multiple No. 1 seeds in the NCAA Tournament ... The ACC had 9 of its 12 teams (75%) competing in post-season play this year - this is the highest percentage of any conference in the country.

THE ACC IN THE AP TOP TIER

The ACC had three teams in the top four of the AP Poll, making this the first season in league history that three of its teams occupied three of the top 4 slots. In the final poll, North Carolina was No. 1, Maryland was No. 3 and Duke was No. 4.

The ACC has had three teams in the top 10 of the AP Poll for a record 16 weeks this season, pushing the league's all-time total to 26 times. Three teams were in the top 10 twice in 1998-99, three times in 1997-98, once in 1996-97 and four times in 1991-92.

ACC IN THE RPI

The ACC was the top-rated conference in RPI, as compiled by Collegiate Basketball News (www.rpiratings.com). The ACC finished the year with:

Three teams in the top 10, the most of any conference.
Six teams in the top 25, the most of any conference.
Eight teams in the top 50, tied for the most of any conference.

HOW THE ACC STACKS UP

The ACC led the nation in non-conference winning percentage this season with a 152-33 mark (82.2 percent). The ACC recorded a winning percentage of at least .500 against every league in the nation this year.

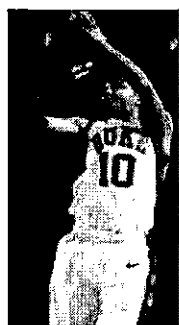
A 6-foot-1 guard/forward, Coleman ranked in the top 10 in the ACC in six statistical categories, including leading the league in three-point shooting.
